National Career Service (NCS) is a one-stop solution that provides a wide array of employment and career related services to citizens of India. It works towards bridging the gap between job-seekers and employers, candidates seeking training and career guidance, agencies providing training and career counselling by transforming the National Employment Service.

The key features of the National Career Service (NCS) portal include:

1. **Services to Employers:** From entry-level workers to mid management level executives, NCS enables employers to find the right fit for their organization through a country-wide database of verified workforce. The employers can register through a simple registration process and gain access to a large workforce. They can also search suitable candidates, send interview invites, participate in events and job fairs etc.
2. **Career related services to Job-Seekers:** Through an easy registration process, job seekers can avail a wide spectrum of career related services, search and apply for jobs, participate in job fairs, enrol for counselling sessions and apply for skill training. NCS also contains a rich knowledge repository of over 3500 job roles and career options for career related information required by job-seekers
3. **Counselling Services:** The National Career Service (NCS) creates a Network of Career Counsellors on the NCS platform for the Job Seekers. The main aim of career counselling is to assist the job seekers in choosing a field that is in tune with their skills and their career expectations. A Job Seeker can browse through the list of the approved counsellors and book an appointment with them.
4. **Job Fairs and Events:** The list of all the upcoming events and Job Fairs is available under the “Job Fairs & Events” section on the Home Page. Employers can post and Job Seekers once registered on the portal, can attend the job fairs.
5. **Model Career Centres:** An integral component of the NCS Project is the establishment of Model Career Centres in collaboration with States. The Career Centres serve as a platform for addressing all career related needs of the youth and students seeking counselling and employment.
6. **Local Service Providers (LSP):** The NCS users can also register as local service providers on the NCS Portal to provide specialised services such as driver, electrician, plumber etc. and households/users can find information of nearest local help by searching these LSP's and take their services as per requirement
7. **Skill Training:** A Job Seeker can avail the benefits of various skill trainings and certificate courses which are provided by various skill providers registered on portal. One can also view the list of skill providers based on geography or the areas of interest.
